





Vision and Aims




The aim of the Program is the contribution of the Social Sector to Integrated Care of patients with chronic diseases (COPD, asthma, heart failure, coronary heart disease, diabetes etc.), by providing innovative comprehensive services of combined medical-social care.











«1st Phase (In Person) "Rehabilitation"



Participation of patients in interdisciplinary evaluation and training groups, lasting 30 hours (10 three-hour sessions), by the specialized medical, nursing and psycho-social staff of the Program,



«2nd Phase (Remote) ICT and AI assisted continued and coordinated care



Continuous remote monitoring of patients and coordination of care, horizontally and vertically, with the use of new technologies, by specialized staff (Case managers), regardless of place and time.


